After lunch there might be a site visit (To be confirmed)

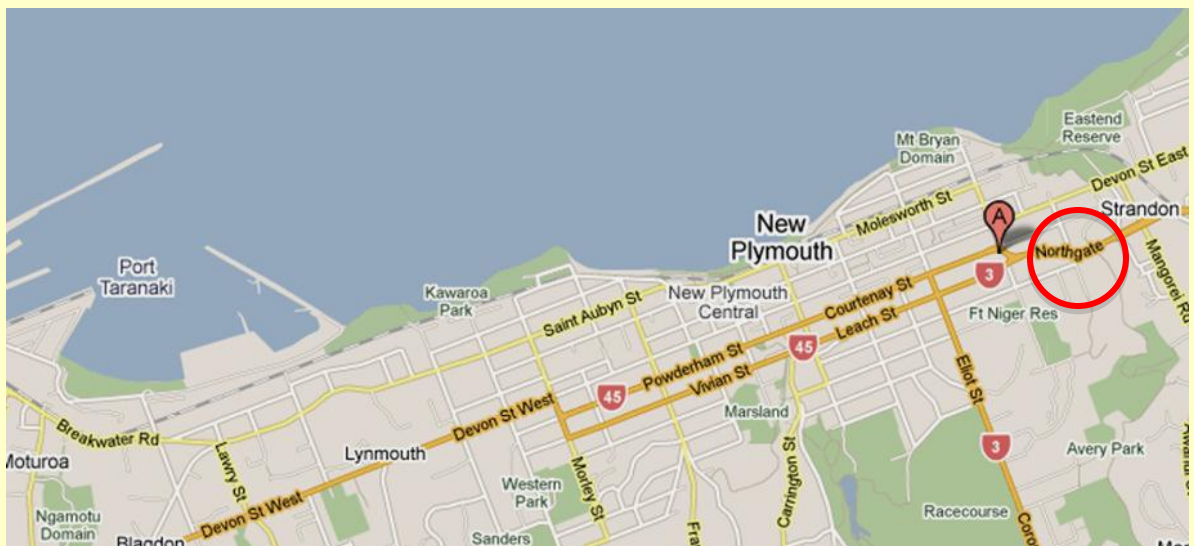
The seminar precedes the NZ Branch Society AGM which will be held at the end of the afternoon sessions.
